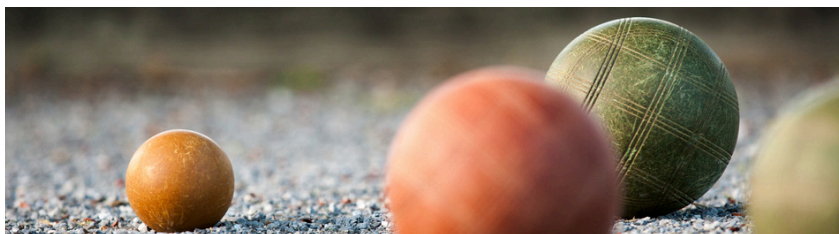

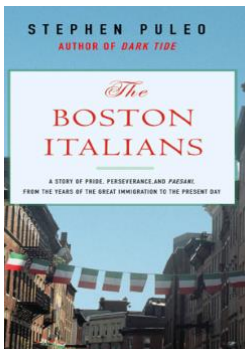
Join us in celebrating 100 years at 3 events:

CYCLONE HARRY RELIEF FOR SOUTHERN ITALY

Dear Members:

On January 21, 2026 the severe weather associated with the Mediterranean Cyclone Harry hit Sicily, Calabria and Sardinia with particular intensity, heavily affecting roads, railroads, maritime transport and the airport system. The event caused wind gusts of up to 75 miles per hour, storm surges with waves reaching 33 feet and exceptional rainfall, with local accumulations exceeding 1 foot. Operationally, the impact translated into service suspensions, precautionary closures, safety-related restrictions and a prolonged recovery phase affecting coastal infrastructure. Although no fatalities were recorded in Italy, the toll included the evacuation of 190 people in Sicily and about 150 in Sardinia, as well as damage estimated at more than \$500 million in Sicily alone, according to the President of the Region.

Cyclone Harry has left a trail of devastation across Eastern Sicily, Southern Calabria and Sardinia. Beaches have been completely wiped away. Historic piers lie in ruins. Charming boardwalks where families strolled for generations are gone. Coastal restaurants that fed communities for decades have been eliminated. Fishing boats, which are the lifelines for local families, now sit stranded in the streets. Behind every destroyed landmark is a family whose livelihood has vanished overnight.

To address this devastation, the State Charity Commission in conjunction with the Charitable & Educational Trust and the Lawrence Ladies Lodge, is hosting a fundraiser at Salvatore's Restaurant, 354 Merrimack Street in Lawrence, MA, on Sunday, June 7, 2026 at 1:00 PM. Pasta and meatballs, salad, bread, desserts, coffee and tea will be served. A cash bar and raffles will be available. Tickets are \$35.00 per person.
